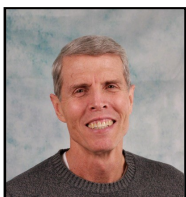
Joe Shuffett — Camp Pastor

camp guidelines

In the interest of safety and community, the following guidelines will be enforced. Thank you for your cooperation with these expectations.

1. Upon arrival all campers must register at the camp office in Young Lodge.
2. Campers under 18 must have an adult parent or supervisor who will be responsible for the camper's actions and safety at all times, and campers are not to leave the campgrounds without parent/sponsor permission.
3. Parents and guardians are to ensure that children and youth are not together in private quarters without adult supervision.
4. Fighting, profanity, firearms, fireworks, and the use of tobacco, alcohol or illegal drugs, are not allowed at the camp. All nerf weapons, gellet, airsoft, and similar toys should be left at home.
5. Modesty and good taste in personal attire are expected while on the grounds. Shoes and shirts are required in the Dining Hall and the Snack Shop pavilion.
6. For the comfort of our campers, quiet hours are from 11:00 pm to 7:00 am. All non-campers should be off the grounds by 11:00 pm.
7. Dogs and cats are not allowed into any of our camp buildings. If you are staying in a camp-owned cabin, chalet or other room, please make arrangements to leave your pet at home for the week. Pets in the RV area must be kept quiet and on a leash at all times. All droppings must be promptly cleaned up by the owner. Owners must also be ready to demonstrate proof of pet vaccinations.
8. Our campers' insurance is for injuries only and begins where yours terminates. In the event you have no personal or organizational policy, our policy will provide you with coverage within its limits subject to policy provision.
9. Rules for acceptance and participation in camp are equal for all regardless of race, color, national origin, sex or handicap.
10. Durley Camp & Retreat Center is a ministry of the Gateway Conference of the Free Methodist Church.
